Vital Statistic Report 2020 - 2021

From August 2020 to August 2021, there were 60 students enrolled in the Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program. Student demographics for this reporting period include 16 male students (1 Hawaiian/Pacific Islander; 15 White) and 44 female students (3 Asian; 1 Black; 2 Hispanic; 38 White). Between August 2020 and May 2021, there were 29 graduates from the Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program. The completion rate of full and part-time students who were enrolled in the program during this period was 97%. Full-time students who finish their degrees on time do so in two years (including a summer semester between the first and second years). Part-time students can take 3-7 years to graduate. The current pass rate for students who took the NCE during the term of this report was 100%. This pass rate does not reflect data on all students, some of whom may have taken the exam from a center that does not report the data. The NCE is the licensing exam that is used in most states. Regarding students who were actively seeking employment after graduation, 100% report finding employment. During this period, the CMHC Program received 113 applications.
