MEASURE	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED	
Career Placement Rate	The Career Placement Rate is determined through a comprehensive survey of 2023 graduates conducted by the	

Franciscan University Office of Personal Vocation. The survey determines a successful career placement as being either a full-time job in the graduate's field of study or continued study in graduate school within 12 months of graduation. The survey response rate for graduates ranged from 75% for the BS in International Business to over 90% for all the other BS majors and the MBA degree. Franciscan University habitually achieves high response rates for this survey that measures a critical success metric for the Department of Accounting, Business Administration, and Economics. There is a usual lag in the graduation year report compared to the Academic Year it is reported for. More simply, it collects outplacement data for the 2023 graduation year during the 2023-2024 Academic Year and collates it in mid-2024. Data on 2023 MBA graduates were collected via LinkedIn searches conducted 12 months post-graduation (in 2024).
